GUIDANCE FOR PEOPLE USING THE COURT

- The court will remain locked when not in use and the tennis net will remain in place at all times. The only ball game the court may be used for is tennis.
You may book the court by emailing [bookings@sca2004.org.uk/](mailto:bookings@sca2004.org.uk) or by phoning Will on 732210.
- Encourage everyone in your group to wash/sanitise their hands at frequent intervals and, as a minimum, before and after using the court. Wash your hands when you get home.
- You **MUST** maintain social distancing from others unless they are from the same household - current advice is to maintain at least two metres where possible.
Do not consume food or drink in the court area.
- If you or any member of your household has coronavirus symptoms, or have been advised to self-isolate, go home and do not use this equipment.
- This equipment is checked regularly for damage, wear and tear, but will not be sanitised regularly. You may wish to sanitise the equipment before you use it.
- Encourage everyone, especially children, to avoid touching their faces, particularly after using equipment. Cough or sneeze into a tissue or arm when a tissue is not available.
- The court should only be used by one group at a time (maximum size 6) while social distancing.
- If following immediately after another group please maintain social distancing at the gateway and allow the group leaving plenty of room.
- Please take all used wipes, gloves, face coverings etc. away. Use bins where provided.
- We hope you enjoy using the court and thank you for helping to keep everyone safe by always following these simple instructions.
